



EYE SOCCER SPORTS RULES

The EYE SOCCER rules are based on those of the Fédération Francaise de Football but have been adapted on certain points to take into account the participation of foreign clubs (which have different rules), the size of the pitches and our concept of events.

ARTICLE 1 - TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE

Participation in the tournament implies acceptance of the sporting regulations (see table) and these rules.

All cases not covered by these rules, as well as any disputes, will be submitted to the Tournament Committee, which will make the final decision. Sporting fairness will be our guiding principle. The Tournament Committee will communicate only with the team's coach.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to modify these rules if unforeseen conditions (weather or other) disrupt the initial programme.

ARTICLE 2 - LICENCES AND MATCH REPORTS

All players, educators and accompanying managers must have a licence from their federation.

The licence must be linked to the club they represent.

At any time, the club must be able to produce proof of identity or a copy of the proof of identity of the players, instructors or managers or their licences, if requested by the organising committee. Any club presenting managers/educators and players who are not licensed, who are licensed with another club, who are playing on false licences or who are out of age category may be disqualified.

Professional clubs wishing to field trial players must request authorisation from the organisers and provide the licence number of the player's club of origin on the match sheet.

The match report must be sent before the start of the tournament within the deadline set by the organisers. This will be done online via a link sent by the organisers.

If you make a mistake, you can fill in the form again, but the latest version will be taken into account. If the match form is missing or incomplete, the team may be refused participation or receive sporting penalties.

ARTICLE 3 - SPIRIT OF THE TOURNAMENT

EYE SOCCER 'another vision of football' attaches importance to Fair Play and wants to promote clubs with a state of mind that is close to the values of our association: RESPECT-EXCELLENCE-PLEASURE.

*TEAM

> The team arrives on time for the tournament and complies with the tournament schedule.

- > The match report is sent in by the requested deadline.
- > The team shows fair play:
- Respect for people: organisers, referees, team-mates and opponents, coaches and the public.
- Respect for facilities, equipment and cleanliness
- Respect for sportsmanship: encouragement, fighting spirit during the tournament.

***TEACHER**

> Adopts a fair play attitude throughout the tournament.

> Adopts a benevolent attitude by encouraging his players, without shouting from the sidelines as if he were playing in the World Cup.

> Adopts a respectful attitude, particularly towards the referee, without contesting his decisions.

***PARENTS**

> Parents respect the festive spirit of the tournament (singing, cheering) and applaud all the players at the end of the match.

> Parents do not give any instructions to the players and do not under any circumstances question the tournament referees or the coach during the match AND do not come to the tournament management committee to ask for any explanation.

***SPORTING EQUALITY**

All teams must provide a competitive team throughout the tournament with a sufficient number of players.

***SOLIDARITY**

The club is committed to playing an active and important role in the '1000 shoes' operation, collecting shoes that will be sent to a partner country and charity.

Any breach of the spirit of the tournament may result in disqualification of the team, whether caused by the players, educators/leaders or parents accompanying the team.

ARTICLE 4 - BOXES

Referees will issue yellow and red cards to players and instructors/leaders who fail to comply with these sporting regulations or with the spirit of the tournament. Cards may also be issued to parents accompanying a team.

For players:

Ø Two yellow cards in the same match will result in a red card and exclusion from the current match and for the following match.

Ø If a player receives 3 yellow cards in more than one match, he will automatically be suspended for one match. Yellow cards received on Saturday will be cancelled for Sunday, when the count will start again at zero (except for red cards).

 \emptyset In the event of a^{2nd} red card during the tournament, the player concerned will be permanently excluded from the tournament.

<u>Please note:</u> in the event of a red card for a very serious offence or deliberate violence, the tournament committee reserves the right to exclude the player concerned from the tournament.

ARTICLE 5 - ARBITRATION

The referees present at the tournament are officials of our partner, the LIGUE GRAND EST DE FOOTBALL. The tournament committee has full confidence in the referees, they will certainly make mistakes at times, but that's part of the game and you have to accept their decisions.

The tournament committee will not tolerate any disrespect towards the referees and will not go back on the referees' decisions.

ARTICLE 6 - RANKINGS

***GROUP CLASSIFICATION**

Ø DECOUNT 1

In Saturday or Sunday matches, the group classification will be established by counting the following points: Match won: 3 points Draw: 1 point Match lost: 0 points

Ø DECOUNT 2

In the event of a tie in the standings in each group, the teams will be ranked in priority order according to the following criteria:

- 1- Overall goal average
- 2- Number of goals scored
- 3- Result of the match between the ties

In the event of a tie after the above criteria, the tournament committee will propose a solution to break the tie between the teams in question: penalty kicks, extra match or other depending on the context.

***FINAL RANKING**

For the final ranking, as there is no ranking match, it will be established by comparing the points earned in your group with the teams with the same ranking in the other groups.

Example: if you are in the Champions League and you are^{2nd} *in your group, your points will be compared with the*^{2nd-placed} *teams in the other groups playing in the Champions League.*

In the event of a tie-on points, the tie will be broken on the basis of the following criteria: overall goal average, number of goals scored, number of points scored on Saturday, overall goal difference on Saturday, number of goals scored on Saturday.

*GOAL STRIKES

In the event of a penalty shoot-out in the semi-final, final or any other case, 3 penalty shoot-outs per team will be taken by the players present on the pitch at the end of the match. If there is a tie after 3 penalty kicks, sudden death with one kick per team until the two teams are separated.

ARTICLE 7 - DISQUALIFICATION

Any disqualification will result in the elimination of the team.

This situation may favour one or more teams in the group concerned, in which case if a solution allowing qualification on the pitch between the remaining teams in the group is possible, then this alternative solution may be proposed.

Otherwise, all the teams in their group will benefit from a match won by forfeit of 3-0 and therefore 3 points, regardless of the number of matches already played by the disqualified team.

The disqualification of one or more teams is always a difficult decision, but the tournament committee reserves the right to do so for the smooth running of the tournament.

The tournament committee reserves the right to draw up a report to be sent to the club officials and their federation.

The tournament committee reserves the right to take legal action in the event of violence, damage or any other act that impairs the image and smooth running of the tournament.

The tournament committee has no different tolerance depending on whether the club is amateur or professional; the rules are the same for everyone.

Often, amateur clubs think that we favour professional clubs because they 'are professionals' or sometimes even national professional clubs think that we favour prestigious 'European' clubs. This is absolutely not the case, and the way we have operated since the^{1st} edition proves it.

ARTICLE 8 - AWARDS

The teams that reach the semi-finals will be rewarded. All other teams, once they have played their last match, may leave the tournament.

However, for the sake of the tournament atmosphere, it's best to stay until at least the final.

ARTICLE 9 - IMAGE RIGHTS

Clubs taking part in our tournaments authorise EYE SOCCER to take photos and videos and to distribute them for communication purposes.

ARTICLE 10 - LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

The tournament committee accepts no responsibility for any injury, accident or theft that may occur during the tournament to players, attendants or managers.

We invite all participating clubs to take out insurance to cover any inconvenience that may occur during the tournament.

The tournament committee will ensure the presence of first-aid attendants on site and will have civil liability insurance in the event of fault on the part of the organisers.

Saint-Avold disqualifiée

respectées par les parents et les encadrants de l'équipe. La direction de Eye Soccer a décidé de les disqualifier -, justifie Karim Chakhite. Cette disqualification a donné lieu à une triangulaire sur le terrain entre la Juventus, Wolverhampton et Reims.

Le week-end se voulait solidaire aussi puisque l'ECDE de Forbach a renouvelé son opération « 1000 shoes » où elle récupère d'anciennes chaussures de foot pour les envoyer aux enfants défavorisés. Cette année, ce sont 670 paires qui ont été récoltées.

Saint Avold disqualified

The only downer of this festive and sporting weekend, which promoted the values of the sport, was the disqualification of the team from Saint Avold for bad behaviour. "The organisation attaches great importance to fair play and the values of sport. Values that were not respected by the team's parents and carers, and the Eye Soccer management decided to disqualify them"
